RE: COVID-19 Positive Individuals

I am writing to inform you that three individuals associated with Quarry Hill have tested positive for COVID-19 in recent days. These individuals are in isolation, in accordance with Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines.

Contact tracing at Anderson Inn has begun, resulting in the testing of some residents and care team members for the virus. Additional testing is expected to occur later this week and into next week as well.

Residents who have appointments at the Quarry Hill beauty salon in the coming days are asked to call to reschedule for a later date. Likewise, until further notice, we ask that residents from other parts of the community refrain from participating in activities being hosted in the Terraces.

Per usual, we are in communication with the Maine CDC and MaineHealth to ensure that we are taking all the appropriate steps and doing everything possible to keep COVID-19 from spreading within the Inn. Rest assured that all established safety measures—including masking, screening of those entering the Inn, social distancing and increased hand hygiene—continue.

Family members, we will contact you if there are any concerning changes regarding your loved one's health and will continue to provide updates as they become available.
