I am happy to be able to write to you today with good news on the COVID front.

In view of Quarry Hill's most recent COVID test results indicating zero infections, the Maine CDC has given us clearance to resume the group activities at the Anderson Inn that residents were enjoying last fall, before the arrival of the Omicron variant. Watch for posted flyers and other communications in the coming days that will let you know specifically which activities are resuming.

It's important to note that the CDC still identifies our county as an area of "high-transmission." This means that any activities we offer must require all participants to remain <u>socially distanced</u> and <u>masked for the</u> <u>duration of the activity</u> (thus, there can be no eating or drinking involved).
